How to publish documentation for CAST User Community extensions




Summary: Any CAST User Community extension (i.e. a custom extension) requires documentation that is freely available on the internet. CAST highly recommends creating the documentation within the **GitHub repository** you are using for the source code. This page describes the steps required to publish documentation in GitHub.




• Create a **new page** that will contain the extension documentation:
