This section provides a detailed description of the **Architecture Model editor**. This editor essentially provides a means for you to configure your **Architecture Model definition file (.CASTArchitect)** that will be used by the CAST Management Studio to check that your Application conforms to the required architecture as part of the Architecture Checker feature - please see [CAST Architecture Checker](#) for more information about this.

### Main Field Headings

<b>Name</b>	Displays the name of your <b>Architecture Model</b> . In the case of newly created architecture models, this will be displayed as <b>My Architecture Model</b> and all other fields will be empty You can edit the field by selecting it and then modifying or replacing as appropriate. Please see <a href="#">Naming constraints</a> for more information.
<b>Description</b>	Use this area to make notes or remarks about the item.
<b>Architecture Project</b>	Enter the location of your <b>.CASTArchitect</b> file or use the <b>Browse</b> button to select a file.
