Stop Managing an Application

This option enables you to "remove" an Application from the CAST Management Studio, in other words if you no longer want to manage it. When you stop managing an Application you can choose whether you want to also:

- remove any associated snapshots from the [Dashboard Service](#) or [Measurement Service](#)
- remove all analysis result data from the [Analysis Service](#)
- remove any deployed source code stored in the [Source Code Deployment Folder](#)

Remember that when you stop managing an Application it and its configuration settings will NOT be removed from the [Source Code Delivery Folder](#), as such you can use the [Manage an Application](#) action to start working with the Application once again.

To stop managing an Application:

- In the [Applications view](#), right click the Application and select **Stop Managing Application**
- A wizard will then be displayed:

Stop managing this Application

Please provide the options for this action. By default, the Application will be deleted from the Management Service and will be available for other Management Services.

Do you also want to clean up the Dashboard Service, i.e. delete the results from the corresponding database?
If you want to restore this Application, you should keep these results unless you are planning to move this Application to another Dashboard Service.

◆ Delete snapshots from Dashboard Service

Do you also want to clean up the Measurement Service, i.e. delete the results from the corresponding database?

◆ Delete snapshots from Measurement Service (if configured)

Do you also want to clean up the Analysis Service, i.e. delete the results from the corresponding database?
If you want to restore this Application, you should keep these results unless you are planning to move this Application to another Analysis Service.

◆ Delete analysis results

Do you also want to clean up the Deployment folders, i.e. delete the deployed source code that corresponds to the Application's packages?

<p>Delete snapshots from Dashboard Service</p>	<p>Select this option if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you want to completely remove all snapshots associated to the current Application from the Dashboard Service when you stop managing the Application. All relevant snapshot data will no longer be visible in the CAST Dashboard. <p>Do not select this option if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you would like to stop managing the Application but need to view the historic snapshot data in the CAST Health Dashboard/CAST Engineering Dashboard.
<p>Delete snapshots from Measurement Service (if configured)</p>	<p>Select this option if you have an active Measurement Service (see Measurement Service editor) and have chosen to upload snapshot data to the Measurement Service when you generate a Snapshot and:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you want to completely remove all snapshots associated to the current Application from the Measurement Service when you stop managing the Application. All relevant snapshot data will no longer be visible in the CAST Health Dashboard. <p>Do not select this option if you have an active Measurement Service (see Measurement Service editor) and have chosen to upload snapshot data to the Measurement Service when you generate a Snapshot and:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you would like to stop managing the Application but need to view the historic snapshot data in the CAST Health Dashboard.
<p>Delete Analysis Results</p>	<p>Select this option if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you want to completely remove all analysis results data associated to the current Application from the Analysis Service when the Application is deleted. All relevant analysis results data will no longer be visible in the CAST Engineering Dashboard. <p>Do not select this option if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you would like to remove the Application but need to view the analysis results data in the CAST Engineering Dashboard.
<p>Delete the Deployed Source Code</p>	<p>This option will remove the source code packages listed in the table below. These source code packages correspond to the current Version in the Application and have been deployed to the CAST Source Code Deployment Folder (see Preferences - Platform Settings). If you remove the deployed source code you will no longer be able to analyze that Version of the source code.</p> <p>Select this option if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you want to completely remove all deployed source code associated to the current Application from the Deployment Folder when the Application is deleted. <p>Do not select this option if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • you want to retain the deployed source code for whatever reason.

- Select the appropriate options in the wizard and then click **Finish** to complete the Application removal.
- The Application will be removed from the [Applications view](#).
